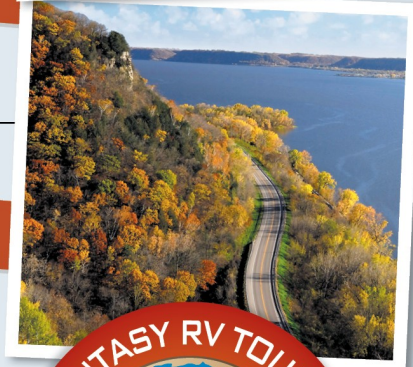

Emergencies & First Aid Information

Call 911

911 calls from cell phones are answered by the CHP. Tell the dispatcher that you are located on the Riverside County Fairgrounds

To aid Emergency personnel in locating the site of an emergency in a parking area, persons needing help should turn on their flashers on their RV's or Towing vehicle and sound their horn

If you need General First Aid while on the grounds, notify Security, anyone with a radio, anyone driving a tram or golf cart

Lock up and protect outside items when away from your RV. Bicycles are an easy target, keep them locked up, especially overnight

Fire Emergency

In the event of an RV Fire emergency please evacuate by foot. Do not attempt to move your RV, because this may present a dangerous situation for fire equipment attempting to enter the area, as well as for others attempting to evacuate on foot

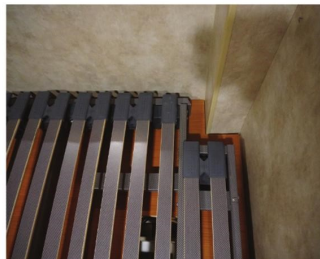

PETS

Pets are welcome at the FMCA Western Area Rally but must be kept in the parking areas unless they are providing service assistance. Operating hours are 7:00 am to 10:00 pm for those not parked in the electric area. A Full Generator Area is available for those needing generator power 24 hours/day
